



# Welcome Chaperones and Volunteers

Your assistance is most appreciated.

Chaperones and Volunteers have different job descriptions. Please note which one you prefer.

**Chaperones** are charged with logistics only and are available in time to assist with the first transport of students to an airport destination. Usually 9:00 am. Please plan to stay to the very end which is 4:40 pm. to reunite returning parents with students. Boy Scout Chaperones may have to stay as late as 5:00 pm while students complete Merit Badge requirements.

The number of chaperones is limited to 1 per every 7 students. As the number of student registrations increase, so will the number of chaperone openings. Since the availability is subject to change, check back often. If you are a parent, guardian, BOD, or youth organizer, your registration will go unchallenged/vetted.

The Aviation Career Camp is a very exciting opportunity and quite informative to all that attend. Adults have often asked that the very same camp be created for them. My attempts at making an adult camp happen, have failed each time. But adults will find that a chaperone slot fills that wish. Because attending the camp is not free, all chaperones will be charged \$150. After registration, a chaperone may request that their fee be considered a non-refundable donation. A 100% tax deductible letter will be sent to an individual or organization in thanks for your participation in making a difference.

**Volunteers** have many more responsibilities. Volunteers start working 3 months prior to each camp. They offer their particular talent such as marketing, web updates, social media, communications, letters, proposals, insurance prep, coordination of speakers, schedule prep, transportation, meals, t-shirts, contacts with teachers, ROTC units, youth organizations, fundraising, to mention only a few. Also, during camp, two may volunteer to photograph all activities. Instagram, Facebook, and Twitter live videos are a required skill of the photographer. Volunteers may request a Chaperone slot after completing their chosen task. The photographer and chaperone slot is at no cost to the volunteer.
